SUBJECT: ACCIDENT RESPONSE GROUP (ARG)

1. PURPOSE. This Chapter correlates to DOE 5530.1A, ACCIDENT RESPONSE GROUP, dated September 20, 1991, by assigning responsibility and accountability and providing administrative and/or contractual guidance to Oak Ridge Operations (ORO) and its contractors. Nothing in this issuance changes any requirements contained in any DOE Directive.
2. CANCELLATION. This Chapter cancels and replaces ORO O 150, Chapter II, Chg. 1, ACCIDENT RESPONSE GROUP (ARG), dated July 23, 1998.
3. APPLICABILITY. The provisions of this Chapter apply to ORO Principal Staff and to contractors to the extent set forth in a contract.
4. RESPONSIBILITIES.
 - a. Leader, Emergency Management Team (EMT).
 - (1) Performs those tasks identified in DOE 5530.1A, subparagraph 8k.
 - (2) Coordinates formulation, maintenance, and implementation of plans and procedures for response by ORO and ORO contractors to a nuclear weapons accident or significant incident.
 - b. Principal Staff.
 - (1) Under whose supervision procurement requests are initiated, perform those tasks identified in DOE 5530.1A, subparagraphs 8l and m.
 - (2) As requested by the EMT, perform those tasks identified in DOE 5530.1A, subparagraphs 8j(1) and (2).
 - c. Contracting Officer's Representatives (COR), as requested by the EMT, perform those tasks identified in DOE 5530.1A, subparagraphs 8j(2) and (3).

CONTRACTOR REQUIREMENTS DOCUMENT

Contractors that are identified in paragraph 3 of this Chapter will accomplish the following:

1. When requested by the COR, develop procedures and provide personnel and equipment to support the ARG.
2. Maintain the Radiation Emergency Assistance Center/Training Site (REAC/TS) in a state of operational readiness and, when requested by the EMT, provide medical assistance to the ARG (Oak Ridge Associated Universities only).
3. Implement the DOE Radiological Assistance Program Region 2 response plans and procedures to support an ARG deployment when requested by the EMT (BWXT Y-12, only).
