SUBJECT: LIFE CYCLE FACILITY OPERATIONS

1. PURPOSE. This Order provides detailed requirements for the Oak Ridge Operations (ORO) activities under Series 430, Life Cycle Facility Operations, by assigning responsibility and accountability and providing administrative and/or contractual guidance to ORO and its contractors.
