**SUBJECT: DEPARTMENTAL MATERIALS TRANSPORTATION AND PACKAGING
MANAGEMENT**

1. PURPOSE. This Chapter correlates to DOE O 460.2, DEPARTMENTAL MATERIALS TRANSPORTATION AND PACKAGING MANAGEMENT, dated September 27, 1995, by assigning responsibility and accountability and providing administrative guidance to Oak Ridge Operations (ORO). Nothing in this issuance changes any requirements contained in any DOE Order.
2. CANCELLATION. This Chapter cancels and replaces ORO O 460, Chapter II, DEPARTMENTAL MATERIALS TRANSPORTATION AND PACKAGING MANAGEMENT, dated February 13, 1997.
3. APPLICABILITY. This Chapter is applicable to ORO Principal Staff. Although the Contractor Requirements Document (CRD) attached to DOE O 460.2 is applicable to contractors, no additional contractor requirements are imposed in this Chapter.
4. RESPONSIBILITIES.
 - a. Group Leader, Environmental Services Group (ESG).
 - (1) Performs those tasks identified in DOE O 460.2, subparagraphs 5e(1)-(7).
 - (2) Provides technical support to the Contracting Officer's Representatives (COR) for implementation of DOE O 460.2.
 - (3) Is the direct contact with Headquarters for issues related to DOE O 460.2.
 - b. Director, Technical Support Division, performs compliance assessments, relating to compliance with safety regulations, to meet those tasks identified in DOE O 460.2, subparagraph 5e(7).
 - c. Contracting Officer's Representatives.
 - (1) Perform those tasks identified in DOE O 460.2, subparagraph 5e(1), (7), and (8).
 - (2) ESG, via the COR, may authorize contractors to perform those tasks identified in 5e(4) and (6).
