SUBJECT: PACKAGING AND TRANSFER OR TRANSPORTATION OF MATERIALS OF NATIONAL SECURITY INTEREST

1. PURPOSE. This chapter correlates to DOE O 461.1, PACKAGING AND TRANSFER OR TRANSPORTATION OF MATERIALS OF NATIONAL SECURITY INTEREST, dated September 29, 2000, by assigning responsibility and accountability and providing administrative guidance to Oak Ridge Operations (ORO) and the National Nuclear Security Administration Y-12 Area Office (YAO). Nothing in this issuance changes any requirements contained in any DOE directive.
2. CANCELLATION. This chapter cancels and replaces ORO O 460, Chapter III, Chg. 1, PACKAGING AND OFFSITE TRANSPORTATION OF NUCLEAR COMPONENTS AND SPECIAL ASSEMBLIES ASSOCIATED WITH THE NUCLEAR EXPLOSIVE AND WEAPON SAFETY PROGRAM, dated March 3, 1999.
3. APPLICABILITY. The provisions of this chapter apply to ORO and to YAO Principal Staff and to contractors to the extent set forth in their contract.
4. RESPONSIBILITIES.
 - a. Manager, YAO, performs those tasks identified in DOE O 461.1, subparagraph 5e.
 - b. Director, Nuclear Safety Division, provides technical support to YAO as requested.
5. REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES. None.
