### SUBJECT: PACKAGING AND TRANSPORTATION

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1. PURPOSE. This Order provides detailed requirements for Oak Ridge Operations (ORO) activities under Series 460, Packaging and Transportation, by assigning responsibility and accountability and providing administrative guidance to ORO.
2. SIGNIFICANT CHANGES. This Order incorporates as a Chapter in the 460 Series the current Oak Ridge Order identified in paragraph 3 below.
3. SUMMARY.
  - a. This revision to ORO Order 460 transmits the following:

Chapter III, Chg. 1, PACKAGING AND OFFSITE TRANSPORTATION OF NUCLEAR COMPONENTS AND SPECIAL ASSEMBLIES ASSOCIATED WITH THE NUCLEAR EXPLOSIVE AND WEAPON SAFETY PROGRAM, dated March 3, 1999, which cancels and replaces ORO O 460, Chapter III, same title, dated February 13, 1997.
  - b. The following Chapters, previously issued, remain in effect:
    - (1) Chapter I, PACKAGING AND TRANSPORTATION SAFETY, dated February 13, 1997.
    - (2) Chapter II, DEPARTMENTAL MATERIALS TRANSPORTATION AND PACKAGING MANAGEMENT, dated February 13, 1997.
