SUBJECT: SAFEGUARDS AGREEMENT WITH THE INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC ENERGY AGENCY

1. PURPOSE. This Order supplements DOE Order 1270.2A, same title, by assigning responsibilities for ORO implementation of the U.S./ International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) Agreement for application of safeguards.
2. CANCELLATION. OR Order 1270.2, SAFEGUARDS AGREEMENT WITH THE INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC ENERGY AGENCY, of 5-16-83.
3. SCOPE. The provisions of this Order apply to ORO federally operated facilities and contractor and subcontractor license-exempt facilities that possess, use, or ship nuclear materials.
4. RESPONSIBILITIES AND AUTHORITIES.
 - a. The Director, Nuclear Materials Control Division:
 - (1) Reviews draft design information questionnaires and facility attachments for operability and effectiveness of provisions on nuclear material control and accountability.
 - (2) Arranges for development of Nuclear Materials Management and Safeguards Systems (NMMSS) software and procedures for processing facility data and reporting to the IAEA.
 - b. The Director, Safety and Environmental Control Division, provides advice and assistance to line management authorities who ensure that health and safety protection is provided to IAEA representatives.
 - c. The Director, Safeguards and Security Division:
 - (1) Informs DOE Headquarters of anticipated termination of IAEA safeguards on nuclear materials or facilities.
 - (2) Reports to DOE Headquarters on unusual incidents or loss of material where required to do so under U.S. laws or DOE directives, policies or practices.
 - (3) Arranges for visitors and escorting of IAEA representatives.

- (4) Assures that facilities establish necessary controls to prevent access to classified information by IAEA inspectors.
- d. The Principal Staff including Contracting Officers/Contracting Officers' Representatives:
- (1) When directed by DOE Headquarters, designate, for their respective facilities, participants to serve as a team for preliminary technical negotiations and for drafting design information questionnaires and facility attachments.
 - (2) Assure that contractor facilities selected for IAEA safeguards take those actions specified for contractor action under subparagraph 8h of DOE Order 1270.2A.
 - (3) Assure that resources available to contractors are adequate to satisfy DOE obligations pursuant to the IAEA agreement.
 - (4) Review proposed draft design information questionnaires and facility attachments for the selected facility under their cognizance for impact of the requirements on facility resources and operations.
