SUBJECT: OR STANDARDS PROGRAM

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1. PURPOSE. This Order establishes the policy and requirements of the OR Standards Program.
  2. SCOPE. The provisions of this Order apply to all related activities under the cognizance of ORO. This includes the ORO Principal Staff and Contractors.
  3. REFERENCE. DOE Order 1300.2, Department of Energy Standards Program, of 12/18/80, Change 1 of 8/13/81, and Office of Management and Budget Circular A-119, Federal Participation in the Development and Use of Voluntary Standards, of October 26, 1982.
  4. POLICY. It is the policy of the Oak Ridge Operations Office to:
    - a. Ensure the development and use of appropriate standards for ORO activities. Preference is given to developing standards through the consensus process. Participation in the activities of voluntary standards developing bodies is encouraged, when such participation is consistent with the DOE policy given in DOE Order 1300.2.
    - b. Rely on domestic or international voluntary standards when such voluntary standards are adequate and appropriate for the intended application except when a mandatory Government standard applies.
    - c. Encourage the development of performance standards, recognizing the need for prescriptive or design standards in some applications.

5. RESPONSIBILITIES AND AUTHORITIES.

a. Assistant Manager for Safety and Environment

Is responsible for implementation of the ORO Standards Program.

b. Director, Quality and Reliability Division

(1) Serves as ORO representative with DOE and other Government agencies in standards policy, liaison, and coordination activities.

(2) Prepares reports to the Assistant Secretary of Policy, Safety, and Environment as required by DOE Order 1300.2. The reports are signed by the Assistant Manager for Safety and Environment.

c. Principal Staff

(1) Implement ORO standards policy in their area of responsibility.

(2) Nominate to Assistant Secretary of Policy, Safety, and Environment, via ORO Manager, representatives to voluntary standards bodies, in their area of responsibility, in accordance with DOE Order 1300.2. Forward completed DOE F 1130.1, Record of Voluntary Standards Committee Participation, to the Director, Quality and Reliability Division for transmittal to Headquarters and record purposes.

(3) Submit to the Director, Quality and Reliability Division, the information required to comply with paragraph 4.b.(6), Chapter I of DOE Order 1300.2, at the end of each fiscal year.

d. Contractors

(1) Encourage participation in National Consensus Standards activities in accordance with DOE 1300.2.
